On debut

Jamal Idris was consigned to watching the All Stars match with the fans last year, but after another stand-out season playing for the Bulldogs in which the big fella also earned himself a sky blue jersey, donning the Indigenous colours for the first time next week will be an honour and experience on a whole other level.

"I was a bit upset because I missed selection in the Indigenous team last season," said Jamal, whose mother is Aboriginal and father a Nigerian. "You can't compare the two jumpers - one represents your heritage, the other your state - but they are both important to a lot of people."

Man down

Inaugural Captain and driving force behind the entire All Stars concept, Preston Campbell was understandably shattered upon ruling himself out of the contest due to a hamstring injury just a few weeks out from the match.

"Last year's Indigenous All Stars game was probably my first and last," conceded the inspirational utility player after the news broke. "This is not selling the Titans or the NRL short, but this is the game I look forward to the most this year. So it was pretty upsetting knowing I wouldn't be playing."

In a sign of just how significant this fixture is to the Titans star, Preston will still lead the team onto the field on the night of the match.
