Gnowangerup is a small wheatbelt farming town, which many of my family worked on, and also around the surrounding areas of Ongerup, Borden and Jerramungup.

DESCRIPTION: The Shire of Gnowangerup is located in the Great Southern area, approximately 354km from Perth and 140km from Albany. Driving through the main street you would think there was nothing to Gnowangerup because it is so small – one main
