"I pledge my commitment to advocating and representing Indigenous people of this country to the day I die," he said, brandishing his award to raucous cheers.



"To the Tribe, thank you for your faith," Troy said. "Thank you to my mother and father.




The map of north Queensland shows where Troy Brady's mob is from, near the Great Barrier Reef.


Below is a picture of coral and shells under water.
