The Torres Strait Islander Flag was designed by Bernard Namok when he was only 15 years old.

He drew a white dari (headdress) in the middle, then a five pointed star underneath to show the five island groups.

The colours are blue for the water, white for peace, green for the land and black for the people.

- 3. When are daris worn?




ACTIVITY 3: FISHING IN THE TORRES STRAIT
